1. Between 1000 and 1600 on 16 October 1954, Wiener Neustadt airfield was observed. Tail sections of two aircraft were seen north of the flight control station near the point where van-like crates had been observed on 5 October 1954. It could not be determined to which aircraft these sections belonged or what their shape was. 1

2. MiG-15 _____ was towed from the field to the aircraft repair shop at Theresienfeld. MiG-15 _____ was parked in front of the hangar at Theresienfeld. 2

3. Three trucks with trailers loaded with timber entered the former tritol factory. The trucks _____ with a lieutenant wearing black-bordered blue epaulets as assistant driver and _____ with a driver wearing black-bordered blue epaulets and an assistant driver wearing red-bordered red epaulets. The Wasser Kaserne, 1 km east of the church in Woellersdorf, which previously had been unoccupied, had been renovated. Windows which previously were boarded up had glass in them. The barracks installation was apparently used as quarters for an air force unit. Motor vehicles entering the barracks installation included one van-like truck belonging to the driving school which arrived from Bad Fischau and van-like truck _____ with a driver wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. 3
