1. Between 0915 and 1130 on 9 October 1954, no aircraft were parked and no personnel were observed at Zwoelfaxing airfield. The barracks installation was apparently lightly occupied by personnel wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. Five soldiers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets were seen in the installation. Five officers wearing blue-bordered blue epaulets left the installation with bicycles in the direction of Schwechat. The cantonment at the southeastern edge of the field was guarded by a sentry. A truck which came from the direction of Himberg proceeded across the eastern section of the field to the hangars. No parked motor vehicles were seen. The Token-type and Fishnet-type radar sets south of the westernmost hangar were not in motion. There were no radio installations northeast of these radar sets. 1

2. Between 0800 and 0900 on 9 October, Altkettenhof in Schwechat was guarded by a sentry wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. An umbrella-shaped antenna on an eight-meter-high mast was located west of the entrance to the installation. 2 No training activities were seen at the installation. Maintenance work was being done by about 30 personnel in the northern part of the installation. Personnel seen there wore black-bordered blue epaulets. No motor vehicles were seen.

1. Comment: According to the present report, a Kniferest-type and a Fishnet-type radar sets which had been observed previously were removed.
