- 5. Commissary Toporkov (8) was the only commissary which continually purchased signal insignia. Magazine 8 (7c) was located in Bukow.
- 6. On 27 September, the headquarters in Werder gave a banquet in the Russian restaurant on the restriced Eisenbahn Strasse in honor of Rosa Thaelmann and the author Anna Seghers. About 40 Soviet officers attended the dinner. In order to procure the desired crystal glasses, of which only 5 were available in the restaurant, Lieutenant Colonel Bondarenko (fnu), chief of the main bureau, drove to the Basa in Werder where he could get 15 glasses, and subsequently to the HO in Potsdam, where he purchased the rest. Major Spilliotin (fmi) sent a German worker with a certificate to the Basa in Rummelsburg in order to buy 15 kg of caviar. Since the caviar was scarce also at this central commissary, only 5 kg could be obtained.
