REMARKS			
This is UNEVALUATED Information			

- Between 0800 and 1130 on 26 October 1954, 30 MiG-15s and 2 Yak-11s were parked at Aspern airfield. There was no flying. There was a 6/10 overcast at an altitude of about 2,000 meters, northwesterly wind of about 20 km/h and good visibility as far as Kahlenberg.
- The AA gun emplacements were occupied by 6 x 37-mm AA guns. A watchtower had been erected at the eastern edge of the western fuel dump. No tank trucks were seen there. One mobile flight control station was parked in front of the large barracks building. An umbrella-shaped antenna was fitted in the center of the roof of the north-south wing of the building. The flight control station was guarded by a sentry wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. Trucks and van-like truck, probably ambulance, all of them with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets were seen there. The umbrella-shaped antenna fitted on a radio truck parked just south of the flight control station had been removed. Six trucks and 4 tank trucks were parked in the sheds of the garage installation. The tank trucks were later transferred to the brick garage in the eastern part of the installation. The long-wire antenna had been dismantled.
- Between 1130 and 1230, on 26 October, children between 6 and 8 years old in building No 7 on Siegesplatz in Aspern, it was believed that the building housed a school for Soviet children. Building No 1 on Enzersdorf Strasse was apparently occupied by Soviet civilians.
- Between 1230 and 1500, the following observations were made in Gross Enzersdorf: Konrad Kaserne was guarded by a sentry wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. Radio truck with driver wearing black-bordered blue epaulets parked in front of the installation and was later seen proceeding toward the airfield. Motor vehicles parked in the yard of the former home for aged people in building No 156 on Kasernen Strasse included 2 trucks, 4 trucks and 3 van-like trucks. Trucks with driver wearing black-bordered blue epaulets and loaded with solid fuel entered the installation. A long-wire antenna with a lead-in extending to radio truck which was parked underneath was seen in the yard of the installation. A radio installation consisting of two masts of different height and a radio trucks was seen at the southeastern perimeter

of Gross Enzersdorf about 20 meters east of the antenna mast with bracings parallel to the mast. 3

1. Comment. Aspern airfield is believed to be occupied by one Soviet fighter regiment.
2. Comment. This VHF antenna (umbrella-shaped antenna) is reported for the first time.
3. Comment. The radio installation, 20 meters east of the outer landing beacon is reported for the first time.
