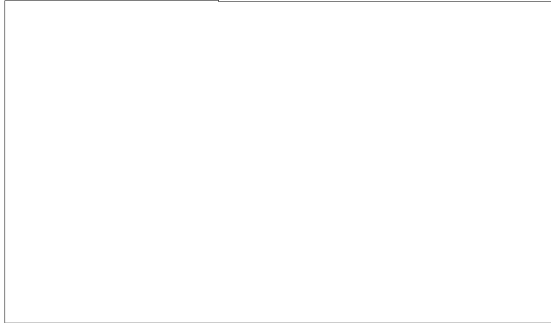

Comment. Compared to the last reported period, hard coal imports from Poland decreased from a daily average of 389 to 347 carloads. The number of empty cars for hard coal shipments increased from 319 to 365. Grain imports from the USSR increased slightly and amounted to 60 carloads per day during the reported period.
