- Only government-operated restaurants are to be found in Braila. The cost of the best meal is 18 led and consists of soup, hors d'oeuvre, roast pork, bread, and a quarter-bottle of vermouth. Other meals drop as low as 2,80 led and consist of a beef broth and bread.
- 2. The following are the rationed and free market prices of food products:

led Black bread 2.50 lei White bread 9 led (free market) 9.50 led (free market) Rice Sugar (per kilo) 3.80 led - 10 led (free market) Meat Pork (with ration lei - 16 lei (free market) ticket) lei (free market) Wine (per litre) Vodka (per litre) 10-12 lei

- 3. The market in Braila was sufficiently stocked in beef, pork, bason and lard. To take care of the requirements of the local population there is no need to stand in line for these items.
- 4. The cost of a man's suit of medium quality is 1,000 to 1,200 lei. A medium grade pair of shoes is 2,000 lei and a cheap watch is 800 lei.
