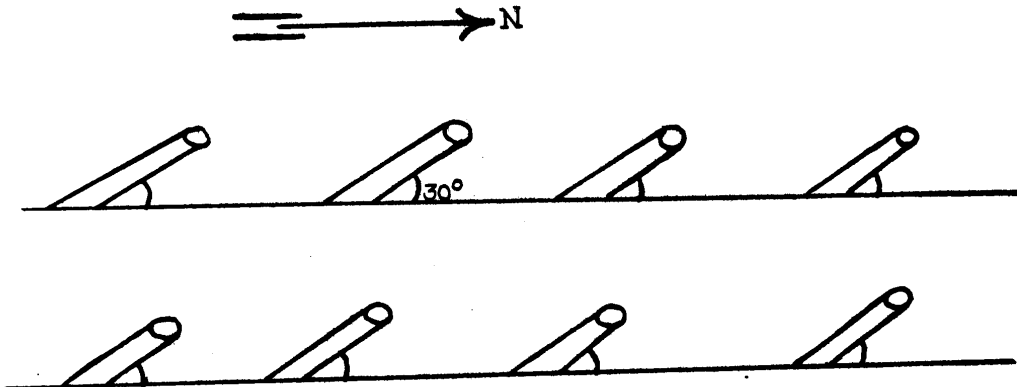

In September 1954 in the area west of Cape Bolshoy Gorodetskiy (N 67-43, E 40-57) at the entrance to the White Sea, a collection of pipes which were installed in rows, with about 1,000 meters between the rows and with several hundred meters' distance between the pipes. The length of the pipes was estimated to be about 25 meters. The pipes were set on a slant with an angle of about 30 degrees between the surface of the ground and the pipes. All of the pipes were directed toward the north (see sketch below).
