2. Considerable construction work was in progress in the bay area. In Vayenga Bay, [REDACTED] several merchant vessels loading or unloading lumber. North-east of Salnyy Island (N 69-08, E 33-26), there were several new buildings on the shore of Kola Inlet, and beyond Salnyy Island on the western shore of the inlet, there were also several buildings and radio masts. 25X1

3. [REDACTED] the eastern point of Rybachiy Peninsula (N 69-42, E 32-36) at night [REDACTED] several illuminated buildings were observable. 25X1
