REMARKS		
This is UNEVALUATED Information		

1. Between 1130 and 1630 on 16 December 1954, there was no air activity at Zerbst airfield. Three MiG-15 or U-MiG-15s were parked in the dispersal area in the northeastern corner of the landing field, and 4 MiG-15 or U-MiG-15s and two unidentified aircraft were seen in front of the southwestern hangar. 25X1
2. The Kniferest-type radar set was still seen in the woods about 1 km in the southwestern extension of the runway. The set was not in operation.
3. On 16 December, 27 soldiers wearing AA insignia proceeded at double time on the Zerbst-Dobritz road. They came from the direction of Dobritz. From the point where the road branches off to the airfield, the soldiers returned marching in a column of three.
4. A group of 1 officer and 12 NCOs wearing black-bordered blue epaulets and carrying suitcases were seen on the road to the Zerbst railroad station. The NCOs wore golden chevrons on their left upper arm, indicating three years of service.
1.  Comment. Zerbst airfield is believed to be still occupied by one fighter regiment equipped with MiG-15s and one reconnaissance regiment equipped with Il-10s. 25X1
2.  Comment. This Kniferest-type radar set was reported previously.  25X1
3.  Comment. An AA gun emplacement in the northwestern corner of Zerbst airfield was last reported in the fall of 1953. 25X1
