The Hungarian Minister of Construction, Lajos Szijártó, who has been in Moscow, returned on 24th December 1954. He immediately called a conference of officials connected with Sztalinváros, and informed them that "it had been decided":

1. to increase the budget for Sztalinváros from 200 million to 600 million forints;
2. to concentrate production of 150-mm. steel plate (alleged to be used exclusively in the manufacture of tanks);
3. to import the required extra iron ore from Yugoslavia.
