1. The Committee for Cultural Relations with Foreign Countries (KWKZ) is a highly important institution which supposedly propagates the exchange of culture with other countries. In reality this is just a blind for propagating not culture but communism. It is run by various people the most important of whom are: Wojciech Chabasinski, Karel Wende, and Mirabel. 25X1
2. All these three are Jews and Chabasinski, who is the most important, is in direct contact with the UB. There is a committee formed of about twenty of the most eminent persons in the cultural field, which is officially supposed to run the KWKZ. This committee is under the auspices of Premier Cyrankiewicz and meets only about once a year. It is a curtain behind which hides the executive office, consisting of the three above-mentioned people, which is the real authority.
