1. During May 1954, casual observation indicated that there was no substantial Soviet Air Force strength in the Estonian SSR. In the middle of May, fewer than 10 twin-engine aircraft were seen flying over Tallinn. They appeared to have twin tails; they were bombers based on Lasnamae airfield at Tallinn. 25X1
2. During the same period, approximately six jet fighters, apparently from Lasnamae airfield, were observed flying singly over Tallinn. 25X1
3. During a brief period of April 1954, a large number of jet fighters were seen flying over Riga. 25X1
