1. Between 0815 and 1330 on 25 January 1955, 22 MiG-15s and 2 Yak-11s all of which were covered by tarpaulins were parked at Parndorf airfield. There was no air activity. There was a 10/10 overcast at an altitude of about 1,000 meters, southeasterly wind of about 8 km/h and good visibility as far as the Leitha mountains. There was only little activity at the field. Some motor vehicles were seen proceeding to the aircraft parked at the eastern edge of the field. 25X1
2. The AA gun emplacements were occupied by 4 x 37-mm AA guns and guarded by sentries wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. Personnel wearing black-bordered blue epaulets were laying telephone cables near the temporary buildings. Eighteen motor vehicles were parked under the lean-to roofs. Two trucks, [redacted] 4 van-like trucks [redacted] 5 tank trucks, [redacted] and 2 Moskvich-type van-like trucks were parked in the open. Seven tank trucks were parked under the lean-to roof in the fuel dump. The Fishnet-type radar set and the Kniferest-type radar set were not in operation and were guarded by sentries wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. One MiG-15 with dismantled tail, 1 crane, 4 gray crates, and 1 van-like crate were seen next to the aircraft repair shop. Four men in overalls were working on the fuselage of the MiG-15. Trucks [redacted] [redacted] van-like truck [redacted] and jeep No / 1-13-85, all of them with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets proceeded from or to the field. 25X1

3. Between 1400 and 1500, the former agricultural school in Bruck/Leitha was guarded by a sentry wearing black-bordered blue epaulets. Two majors wearing blue-bordered blue epaulets and 1 major wearing red-bordered black epaulets with artillery insignia entered and left the installation. Trucks [redacted] [redacted] all of them with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets were seen in traffic. 25X1
