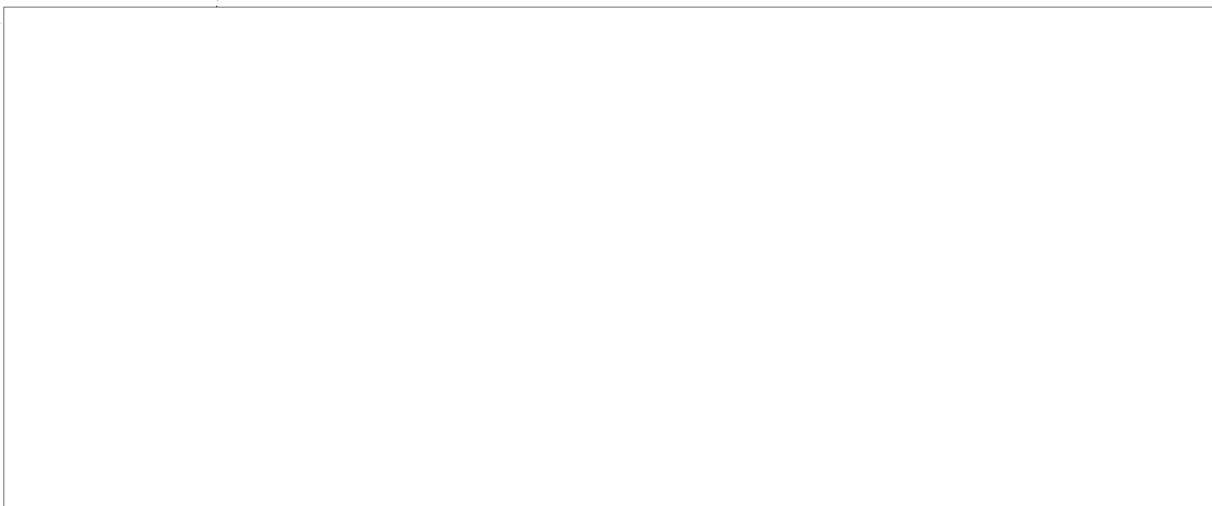
REMARKS

1. The work plan of the KVP Central Tank Repair Shop at Neubrandenburg in January 1955 included repair work on 6 SP guns of 76-mm, 3 T-34/76 tanks and 11 T-34/85 tanks. 25X1  
 overhauling of 3 or 4 vehicles could not be completed in January, since several new engines which had to be delivered from Wursen in mid-January had not yet arrived.
2. An ordnance course for 12 KVPs began on 15 January. One of the students came from the KVP office Karpin I. Another course for about 25 KVPs began at the same time. 25X1
3. It is noteworthy that a rather large number of Soviet officers and KVP officers has visited the installation since mid-January. In building II, the first washing bay started operation.
