1. Comment. Deliveries from East German hydrogenation plants to the USSR and Poland. 25X1
2. Comment. Deliveries from the uranium ore mining district in Saxony. In 1954, a total of 120,000 tons of uranium ore were shipped to the USSR. In 1955, index figure 97 is apparently assigned to uranium ore shipments. Index figure 69 was used in 1954. 25X1
3. Comment. Probably export deliveries from East German motor vehicle plants. 25X1
4. Comment. It cannot be determined whether an intra-zonal shipment or a shipment from the USSR was concerned. Guben has rarely been used for the shipping of weapons and equipment from the USSR. 25X1
5. Comment. Deliveries by East German railroad car factories to the USSR. The Soviet-gauge wheel sets carried along are used on the new cars in the USSR. 25X1
6. 25X1
7. Comment. The shipment to Wildpark possibly consisted of weapons or motor vehicles. the shipment to Jueterbog, and probably also that to Koethen, consisted of fuel. 25X1
9. Comment. This shipment was previously reported Altangrabow as receiving station. . 25X1
10. Comment. Possibly ration supply shipment. 25X1
11. Comment. Possibly tanks returned to the USSR after the arrival of new P-54 tanks. 25X1
12. Comment. This shipment was connected with the motor vehicle exchange program. 25X1
13. Comment. Ammunition from the USSR to the GSFC depot in Toepchin. 25X1
