1. Between 0800 and 1500 on 10 March 1955, 38 MIG-15s, 2 Yak-11s and 1 biplane w^{25X1} observed at Wiener Neustadt airfield. ^{25X1} The depression near the pyrotechnics plant could not be reconnoitered. There was no air activity. There was a 10/10 overcast at an altitude of about 1,000 meters, light snowfall after 0900, northeasterly wind of about 10 km/h and good visibility for about 700 meters. Throughout the reported period 3 Stalin tractors with snow clearing devices were employed. One lieutenant colonel and 4 majors, all of them with blue-bordered blue epaulets entered or left^{25X1} the flight control station.

The doors of the garages were closed. Six trucks, 2 van-like trucks, 1 mobile flight control station and 1 Stalin tractor were parked under the eastern lean-to roofs. Repair work was being done on 2 additional trucks. Van-like truck ^{25X1} and trucks ^{25X1} were seen in traffic. The southern AA gun emplacement and bunker area were unoccupied and unguarded. Motor vehicles were still parked northwest of the emplacement. One truck with hoisting gear, 2 gray crates but no aircraft were seen at the aircraft repair shop. Noises indicating repair work in the hangar were not heard. ^{25X1} ^{25X1}

2. The doors of the hangar of the aircraft repair shop at Theresienfeld were closed. One crane and 12 gray crates were seen in front of the hangar. Three van-like trucks were parked in the parking lot. Trucks ^{25X1} entered the installation. ^{25X1}

3. Six trucks and 2 van-like trucks were parked under the lean-to roofs in the yard of the Artillerie Kaserne in Wiener Neustadt. Trucks ^{25X1} and van-like trucks ^{25X1} were seen in traffic at the installation. Three trucks, 1 van-like truck and 1 jeep were parked under the lean-to roof of the Nachbichten Kaserne. Moskvich-type van-like truck ^{25X1} was seen passing by the installation. ^{25X1}

Comment. Wiener Neustadt airfield is still occupied by two Soviet fighter ^{25X1} regiments. ^{25X1}
