1. Frauendorf (fnu), head of the East German Ministry for heavy industry, reported on 23 March 1955 that 375,000 tons of crude phosphate would be imported into East Germany during 1955.

2. Of this total, the 30,000 tons planned for the first quarter of 1955 are not expected to arrive during that quarter.

3. For the second quarter of the year, a total of 70,000 tons of Kola-Apatit are assured; an additional 45,000 tons are not yet guaranteed.

4. 90,000 tons are assured for import during the third quarter of 1955 and 70,000 tons are still open for negotiation.

5. The import total for the third quarter calls for 70,000 tons, and
