1. There are 600 persons employed at the VEB Funkwerk Koepenick; there is only one working shift.
2. The 1955 production plan includes the following:
 - a. Sound spectrometer (Schallspektrometer); 20 per month; for export to the USSR and Communist China, and for domestic use.
 - b. Sound analyzer (Schallanalysator); 20 per month; for export to the USSR and Communist China, and for domestic use.
 - c. Standard (Normal) oscillographs:
 - OG 2-1; 50 during October/December for export to the USSR
 - OG 2-3; 25 during January for export to Poland
 - OG 2-4; 40 during October/March 1956 for export to Czechoslovakia
 - d. Small oscillographs:
 - OG 2-6; 20 during January/March for export to China and for domestic use
 - e. Sonic depth sounding equipment (Echolote):
 - 25 during the first half of 1955 - all for the USSR
 - f. Ship's radio stations:
 - 1.2 kw: 20 during October/December for domestic use.
