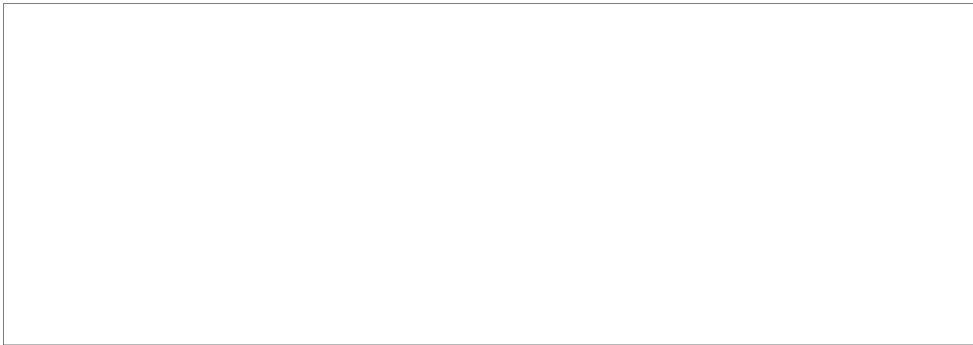

1. Dr. Hans (or Heinz) Barwich, Dr. Werner Schuetze, and Ing. Fritz Bernhard, all recent returnees from the USSR, were commissioned by the East German government to fly to Moscow to negotiate details of an East German atomic pile.
