REMARKS _____

This is UNEVALUATED Information

1. Between 0800 and 1500 on 29 April 1955, a total of 49 MiG-15s, 2 Yak-11s, and 1 biplane were observed at Wiener Neustadt airfield. Weather was 4/10 overcast, ceiling at an altitude of about 2,000 meters, northeasterly wind of about 10 km/h, visibility good. About 1000, MiG-15s began practicing take-offs and landings from southwest to northeast according to the following schedule: 25X1

After landing, all planes taxied back to the take-off point under their own power. The strip used for take-offs and landings had the width of about eight MiG wing-spans and was marked by white flags. 1 Truck _____ sedan _____ and van-like truck _____ were seen at the flight control station. The garage and the easterly lean-to roofs were guarded. Four trucks, 1 headquarters bus, and two model Stalin tractors were seen under these roofs. Ambulance _____ were parked in the open. The south AAA emplacement was unoccupied. A van-like truck was fitted with a Kniferest antenna which moved very slowly during air activity. The eastern emplacement was also unoccupied. 25X1

Two MiG-15 crates were seen in front of the aircraft repair point northeast of the flight control station. The noise of a running jet engine was heard from the shed in this repair point.

- 2. One MiG-15, 1 Li-2, 10 gray crates measuring 200 x 70 x 70 cm, and truck [Redacted] were observed in front of the repair shop at Theresienfeld. No changes were noticed at the billets at Theresienfeld. 25X1

- 3. The Artillerie Kaserne at Wiener Neustadt was guarded. About 60 men practiced marching in review under the supervision of five officers in the barracks yard. Motor vehicles observed operating included: Trucks [Redacted] 25X1

The cantonment west of Wiener Neustadt was also guarded. A total of 24 trucks, 2 van-like trucks, 12 x 37-mm AA guns, and 6 model 2 PU-1 light AA guns were seen in the area.
