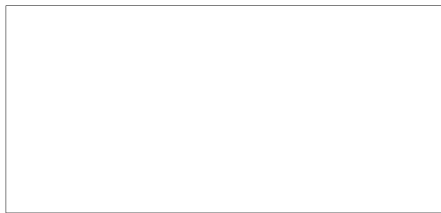

1. The 1955 East German power program provided that the control-circuit installations (Regelschaltwerke) of 40 large-type transformers were to be replaced. These transformers are operating as regulating transformers in the East German power plants. The 1955 Plan provided for 80,000 DME to be spent per transformer for the replacement of the control circuit installations. Replacement of these installations was to be carried out by VEB Transformatoren- und Roentgenwerk Dresden (TRARO). 25X1
2. In mid-May 1955, the Plan was changed and replacement of the control circuit installations in 1955 was cancelled. The Main Administration for Energy in the Ministry for Heavy Industry was instructed that the power plants would have to replace the contacts in their transformers during 1955 instead of obtaining new control-circuit installations. The replacement of contacts was to be financed from the funds provided for general repair. 25X1
3. An order for the delivery in 1955 of 40 control-circuit installations, which TRARO Dresden had received early in 1955, was cancelled in the latter part of May 1955. 25X1
