1. [redacted] partisan activity in the Western Ukraine from 1945 to 1953 [redacted] 25X1

The rumored activities of this group included: disarming small groups of soldiers; harassing military shipments; and killing known Communists. Trains were always sealed and troops were instructed to remain out of sight when passing through the Western Ukraine, so as not to reveal military shipments to the partisans. 25X1

2. In 1948 [redacted] residents of Slout village (N 51-45, E 33-48), Sumskaya Oblast [redacted] some of their relatives had been attacked and robbed while travelling in an unidentified area in the western part of the Ukraine. Those who offered resistance had been killed. [redacted] 25X1

3. [redacted] a train carrying 800 demobilized soldiers returning to the USSR had been blown up and [redacted] all aboard had been killed. 25X1
