The table on page 2 lists the planned production (Warenproduktion) of all the enterprises under the Ministries for Heavy Machine Construction and for General Machine Construction, as of 1 June 1955. The production is broken down according to Main Administrations. The Main Administration for Cable and Apparatus Construction appears in this table as one Main Administration although it is now divided into two, the Main Administrations for Cable and for Electrical Equipment for Vehicles. The old designation is maintained in order to facilitate comparison of the planned production figures in this report with the figures in the original plan project.
2. The figures in this table differ from those listed in the original planned project. The reason is that the production plan was changed after the old Ministry for Machine Construction was divided into the Ministries for Heavy Machine Construction and General Machine Construction. The change was caused mainly by the fact that the division of the old Ministry also brought changes in the affiliations of enterprises under the Main Administrations.
3. The Main Administration for Energy and Power Machine Construction, listed in the following table, was combined from the two former Main Administrations for Boiler and Turbine Construction and for Power and Work Machine Construction.
