- The wearing of insignia commemorating battles during the war of 1877 (against the Turkish Army) has been forbidden to those regiments whose history dates back to that war.
- 3. Rumanian officers and soldiers are free to belong to the Rumanian Military Association "Souvaroff", which is a subsidiary organization within the Soviet association of the same name.
- 4. A part of those veterans wounded in World War II, who from September 1944 until May 1945 fought with the Soviet Army against Germany, no longer receive a pension.
