1. Aircraft Count: (1100 hours on 16 June)

14 IL-28's [redacted] dispersed along the southern runway.

2 MiG-15's on the western taxiway.

1 Yak-14 near the flight control building.

Additional aircraft were parked in one of the hangars the doors which were open.

2. Air Activity:

No air activity was carried out on the days of observation. During the night of 16 June, about 20 IL-28's participated in short cross-country flights of about 25 minutes' duration.
