1. [Redacted] 5 or 6 small naval vessels passed in the side channel past Port Ekonomiya toward Arkhangelsk. They were all alike, motor-driven, each about 120 feet long, with a small gun on the foredeck and one funnel. 25X1
2. On 22 May a floating crane arrived under its own power at Port Ekonomiya with a quay crane. The latter crane was placed on the crane tracks. The floating crane took on one of the other cranes and departed in the evening. There was a total of 4 electric cranes on the quay, each with an estimated hoisting capacity of 5 tons. All the cranes were of different types. On the quay was a large coal pile. Several railway cars loaded with coal left the port area. 25X1
3. Crew lists and passports were checked but there was no muster of the crew. Superficial inspection was performed on arrival, no check was made of the cargo holds during loading, nor were the hatch covers removed for inspection upon departure.
