1. Between 0730 and 0830 on 17 June 1955, no activity was observed on the landing field of Zwoelfaxing airfield. The Token and Fishnet radar stations and the Kniferest and Fishnet radar station remained unchanged. ^{red} 1

Six medium AA guns and one searchlight were in position near the hangars. About 40 soldiers practiced with carbines.

The tops of ~~some tents~~ were seen behind the wall of former Luftwaffen Kaserne.

A new lighting ~~stand~~ has been mounted on one of the brick buildings.

No soldiers were seen in the cantonment where a new lighting ~~stand~~ also been erected.

2. Between 0730 and 0830 on 17 June, sentries were observed at the Altkettenhof at Schwechat military post. Sixteen motor vehicles were seen under the lean-to roofs, and four tents stood in the garden of Altkettenhof. No sentries and no Soviet flag were seen on the komendatura. Sedan [redacted] with driver wearing red-bordered black epaulets parked in front of the commander's office. It could not be clearly observed if the komendatura had been evacuated 25X1t. 2

1. [redacted] Comment. The Kniferst and Fishnet radar sets, which had been reportedly dismantled on 30 December 1954 and 4 May 1955, were, [redacted] newly erected on 11 April 1955. [redacted] 25X1
