1. Gardelegen

- a. The radar installation NW of the airfield, half-way between the airfield perimeter and the Gardelegen-Hemstedt road, consists of one Token Radar and one Fishnet.
- b. The Token revolved at approximately 1 - 1 1/2 rpm.
- c. The Fishnet mast was approximately 6 meters high.
- d. Soviet personnel on the site, numbering 15 - 20 men, lived in an underground bunker. An electric cable leads from the bunker to the radar.
- e. The two Boxbrick radar vehicles at Gardelegen have departed.

2. Tank Training Area - Colbitz

At 2300 hours on 3 June in the tank training area to the NE of Colbitz, 25 tanks were observed. Most of these were T-34s, but some were seen to be larger and with longer guns.

3. Ebrzitz

- a. On the camp site the following are under construction:-
 - 1 Barrack building.
 - 1 House.
 - 8 sheds for tanks.

4. Personnel

The following are Soviet supply officers who deal with SBB transport:-

- a. At Stendal Kaserno: Lebejew and Kris.
- b. At Borstel Airfield: Goroschko.
- c. At Meves Lager: Filipow
