1. Between 0800 and 1530 on 14 July, 24 MiG-15s were observed at Parndorf airfield. There was a 7/10 overcast at an altitude of about 2,000 meters, a northwesterly wind of about 8 km/h, and good visisbility. No air activity was observed. The AA gun emplacement was guarded and occupied by 6 25-mm AA guns. The following motor vehicles were parked under the lean-to roofs:

24 trucks
6 van-like
9 tank trucks,
1 sedan.

Four sedan trucks were used for transferring fuel from 5 railroad tank cars at Parndorf railroad station into the fuel dump. The pump car was used. Two gray crates, 2 small gray crates and 1 Stalin-type tractor were observed near the aircraft repair shop. Vehicular traffic from and to the airfield included:

jeep
truck
van-like truck
sedan) with drivers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets

2. The former agricultural school in Bruck/Leitha ~~river~~ was guarded by sentries wearing black-bordered blue epaulets.

Comment. Parndorf airfield is still occupied by 1 fighter regiment of the 59th Air Army.
