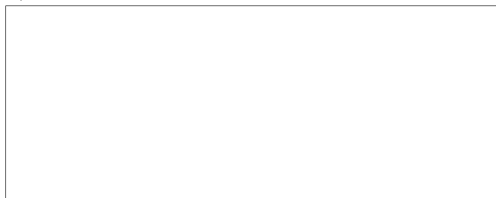

Between 1400 and 1900 on 7 July 1955, 55 MiG-15s and 1 Yak-11 were seen at Wiener Neustadt airfield. There was a 10/10 overcast, intermittent rain, northerly wind of about 25 km/h, and good visibility. No air activity was observed. At 1845, two MiG-15s each were towed by trucks from the western and eastern sides to the northern end of the runway. Jeep [redacted] parked at the southern side of the field and truck [redacted] was parked in a shed.
