1. Between 0800 and 1500 on 11 July 1955, 49 MiG-15s, including those parked near the pyrotechnic installation, were counted at Wiener Neustadt airfield. There was 4/10 overcast at an altitude of about 2,000 meters, intermittent sunshine, northerly wind of about 5 km/h, good visibility, and the Schneeberg Mountain in haze. Between 1121 and 1125, 24 MiG-15s, [redacted] took off from southeast to northwest in the following formations:

- 4 MiG-15s
 - 6 MiG-15s
 - 4 MiG-15s
 - 4 MiG-15s

The aircraft disappeared from view. Between 1211 and 1215, these MiG-15s approached the field in formations of four and landed in elements of two at intervals of 15 seconds each. Landings were made from southeast to northwest. When the aircraft approached the field, [redacted]

Between 1135 and 1147, [redacted] MiG-15s were observed landing, while the take-offs had not been definitely observed, but were recognized by the dust which whirled up [redacted]

The MiG-15s which had landed were towed by trucks to the dispersal areas at Badener Strasse and to the flight-control station. After this procedure [Redacted] trucks and motor vehicles moved to the motor vehicle shed and to the eastern lean-to roofs [Redacted]

The flight-control station was guarded by sentries wearing black-bordered blue epaulets.

Soldiers and seven parked trucks were observed at the southern AA gun emplacement, while no guns could be seen. The eastern AA gun emplacement was equipped with 6 x 37-mm AA guns. The AA gun emplacement of the eastern AA gun emplacement was also equipped with 6 x 37-mm AA guns. Two MiG-15s and 2 van-like crates were observed at the repair hangar.

- 2. Two Li-2s, 10 crates, and 1 truck with hoisting gear were observed at the Theresienfeld repair hangar.

- 3. The Nachrichten Kaserne at Wiener Neustadt military post was guarded by sentries wearing black-bordered blue epaulets.

The Artillerie Kaserne at Wiener Neustadt military post was guarded by sentries who wore black-bordered blue epaulets; four trucks were seen parking at this installation.
