1. On 14, 15 and 16 July 1955, firing by medium AA guns was heard at Apetlon. During the morning of 17 July, firing by medium AA guns was heard. 25X1

2. On 16 July 1955, a column of about 10 trucks towing light AA guns passed through Apetlon and went toward the AAA camp. Trucks [redacted] towing light AA guns [redacted] 25X1

3. The following vehicular traffic was observed between Apetlon and the AAA camp:  
13 July. Trucks [redacted] driven by soldiers with red-bordered black epaulets. 25X1
