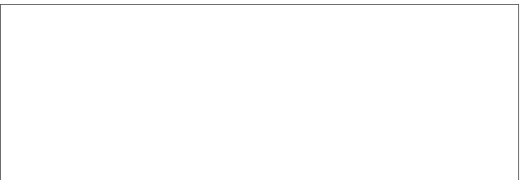

1. Between 5 and 22 July and on 19 July 1955, the following observations were made when passing Parndorf airfield; 25X1
 Between 5 and 13 July, 25 jet engine aircraft remained unchanged at the airfield. On 14 July, 10 additional jet aircraft were stationed at the field. [REDACTED] 25X1
 [REDACTED] These planes were no longer observed in the afternoon of 21 July. 1 25X1

2. According to observations made on 29 July, the barracks in the southwestern corner of the field were dismantled and ready for transportation. [REDACTED] 25X1
 [REDACTED] about 300 cubic meters of timber and 50 to 80 cars loaded with coal were dispatched from Parndorf airfield to Hungary. 2 25X1

1. [REDACTED] Comment. Presumably Parndorf airfield is still occupied by a Soviet fighter regiment. This [REDACTED] seems previous information on an increased occurrence of aircraft at the field on 14 July and is incompatible with a previous report showing [REDACTED] MiG-15s. [REDACTED] 25X1
 [REDACTED] cannot be [REDACTED] the number of 24 MiG-15s currently [REDACTED] and MiG-1 [REDACTED] the field on 14 July 1955. It is not known from where [REDACTED] additional [REDACTED] came.

2. [REDACTED] This is the first indication of the departure of the Soviet [REDACTED] 25X1
 [REDACTED] Parndorf airfield.
