Between 0800 and 1230 on 24 July 1955, 46 MiG-15s were counted at Wiener Neustadt airfield. There was a 2/10 overcast at about 1,500 meters, sunny, westerly wind of about 5 km/h, and good visibility.

The parking place at the eastern edge of the field was not used. Supports, ladders and wooden huts were torn down. The aircraft which were parked so far at this place were apparently transferred to the southern portion of the field. The number of aircraft observed at the southern portion was increased.

Four MiG-15s which were apparently ready for take-off were parked east of the northern end of the runway. The upper sections of the rudder units were painted with yellow color.

The AA gun emplacement at the eastern edge of the field was unoccupied while tents and trucks were still available.

The AA gun emplacement at the southern edge of the field was evacuated.

Comment. Wiener Neustadt airfield is apparently still occupied by two Soviet fighter regiments.
