## A. Surmary of the Suggestion:

Suggester proposed that consideration be given to providing easily identifiable specially-marked envelopes to safeguard all SI material bandled in the Agency. On each envelope the words "Special Handling Required" were suggested.

## B. Evaluations of the Concerned Offices:

Smief, Special Intelligence Security Branch, OCI on 7 December 1956 made the following statement:

"It should be pointed out that the CCI Registration Section currently utilizes 9 different sizes of specially prepared envelopes for the handling and distribution of SI material. These envelopes graduate in size from  $\theta_2^1$  x 11 inches to 12 x 16 inches and bear distinctive markings in addition to the appropriate security classification. While the CCI Registration Section is the only mail room using such envelopes, steps will be taken by the CCI Security Office to coordinate the utilization of such envelopes with the various office representatives so that a uniform system will be used throughout the entire activity."

Assistant to UD/I (Administration) pointed out the <u>lack of administration</u> in the use of these envelopes and therefore considers the suggestion worthy of an award based on intangible benefits (local-slight).

## C. Recommendation of the Executive Secretary:

Approval. Award of \$10-25 based on local-slight intangible benefits.
