A. Summary of the Suggestion:

Suggester proposed and put in use a lumber dolly. This dolly is constructed by using two 6' dollies and fastening them together with 3/8 inch steel cables. It is so constructed that it can turn sharp corners and carry lumber, rugs, etc. up to 15' long.

B. Evaluation of the Concerned Offices:

The Office of Logistics on 16 November 1956 stated the following:

"This contribution is commendable on the part of the person who submitted the suggestion and it is pleasing to note the initiative displayed on the part of the employee."

"The suggestion has been used at the Washington Depot for some time. However, its use is very infrequent and does not involve a saving of time or money, but is rather a device of convenience. On this basis, no award is recommended; however, a commendation is believed in order."

C. Recommendation of the Executive Secretary:

Approval. Award of \$10 to \$25 based on intangible benefits (albeit benefit limited application) for suggester's ingenuity and the acknowledged convenience of his idea.
