A. Summary of Suggestion

"It is suggested that a bus shelter be erected (similar to the ones at Tempos I, J, K and L) for the bus stop at R&S Building, thereby allowing Agency employees to receive some protection while waiting in inclement weather. Nearly all other Agency buildings have some sort of protection available.

"The shelter could be erected inside the fence. Each night when the gate was locked, the shelter would be protected from acts of vandalism. The material for construction should be taken from buildings where partitions are being removed, resulting in a small cost to the Agency."

B. Summary of Evaluations

On 10 December 1957 the Office of Logistics stated:

"The basic idea behind this Suggestion is not a new one. Shelters for personnel were erected at certain bus stops sometime ago. However, subject Suggestion has prompted this Office to send a reimbursable work order to the Public Buildings Service covering the erection of a shelter inside the fence at the R&S Building location.

"It is recommended that the Suggester be given a nominal cash award based on intangible benefits which will accrue to Agency personnel."
