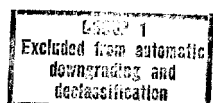

A. Summary of Suggestion

Construction of a shelf-set insert which provides needed storage space in the new style desks and which blends with the decor has been fabricated by the suggester and is in use in Room 3 E 58A. It offers two shelves approximately 17" long by 12" deep and is situated in space that has no value for other purposes. The entire unit is easily positioned in less than 5 seconds and requires no screws, bolts, or other means of attachment. Materials costing less than \$1.00 at retail prices were used in its construction. Suggester proposed that shelf sets be made available as a routine supply item to free expensive safe space and remove inefficient and unsightly desk-top clutter. (See sketch attached.)

B. Summary of Evaluation

20 November 1963, OL reported that a group of these shelves had been constructed by the Carpenter Shop, GSA, and made available in the Building Supply Office with a sign stating their use and that they were the result of an Employee Suggestion. If and when new requests come in, the shelves will be constructed by the Carpenter Shop.

4 February 1964, Suggester reported that he obtained additional sets from the Supply Room for use in his immediate area.

Suggester proposed that a flashing red light be installed upon or within the GPT-750 radio transmitter as a safety first modification to remind the technician of the danger of contact with this high voltage while performing the general maintenance of these transmitters.

B. Summary of Evaluation

CC recommended adoption 19 March 1962.

The GPT-750 transmitter is standard military and commercial unit and as such meets normal safety standards. The suggested modification should reduce the possibility of injury or death as a result of electrical shock on the part of the man performing maintenance.

On 5 October 1962, CC Engineering Staff reported the safety device is henceforth a standard required modification.

A. Summary of Suggestion

Suggester proposed that an "Equipment Information Manual" be made on all common communications equipment such as transmitters, receivers, teletypes etc., to include stock number, width, height, depth, cube, weight, watts of power, and operating voltages. Such a manual would give an engineer planning an installation complete information for determining power requirements, air conditioning requirements, floor loading, shipping requirements, and stock numbers which would save many hours of searching and calculating for each individual requirement.

Chief, OC-E noted that most of the data considered in this suggestion has been compiled in a brochure by the Headquarters Engineering Staff. Since several weeks usually pass between the arrival of Form 1173 and the day the subject enters on duty, this file soon becomes bulky, difficult to manage, and related procedures interfere with smooth processing of EOD's.
