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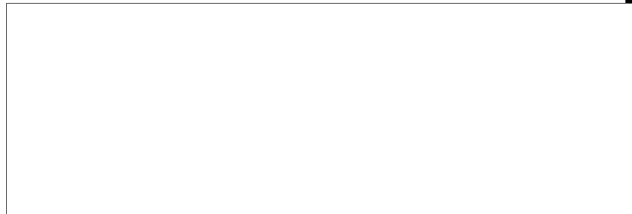
1. The Medical Office concurs in the proposed regulation and is of the opinion that it will serve a useful purpose.

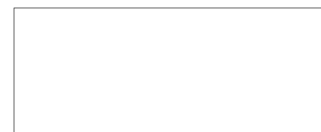

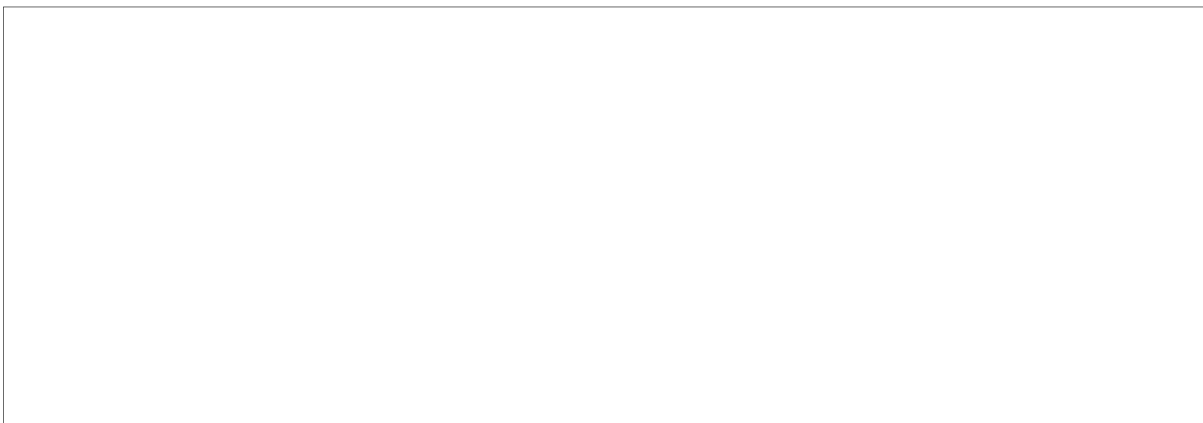

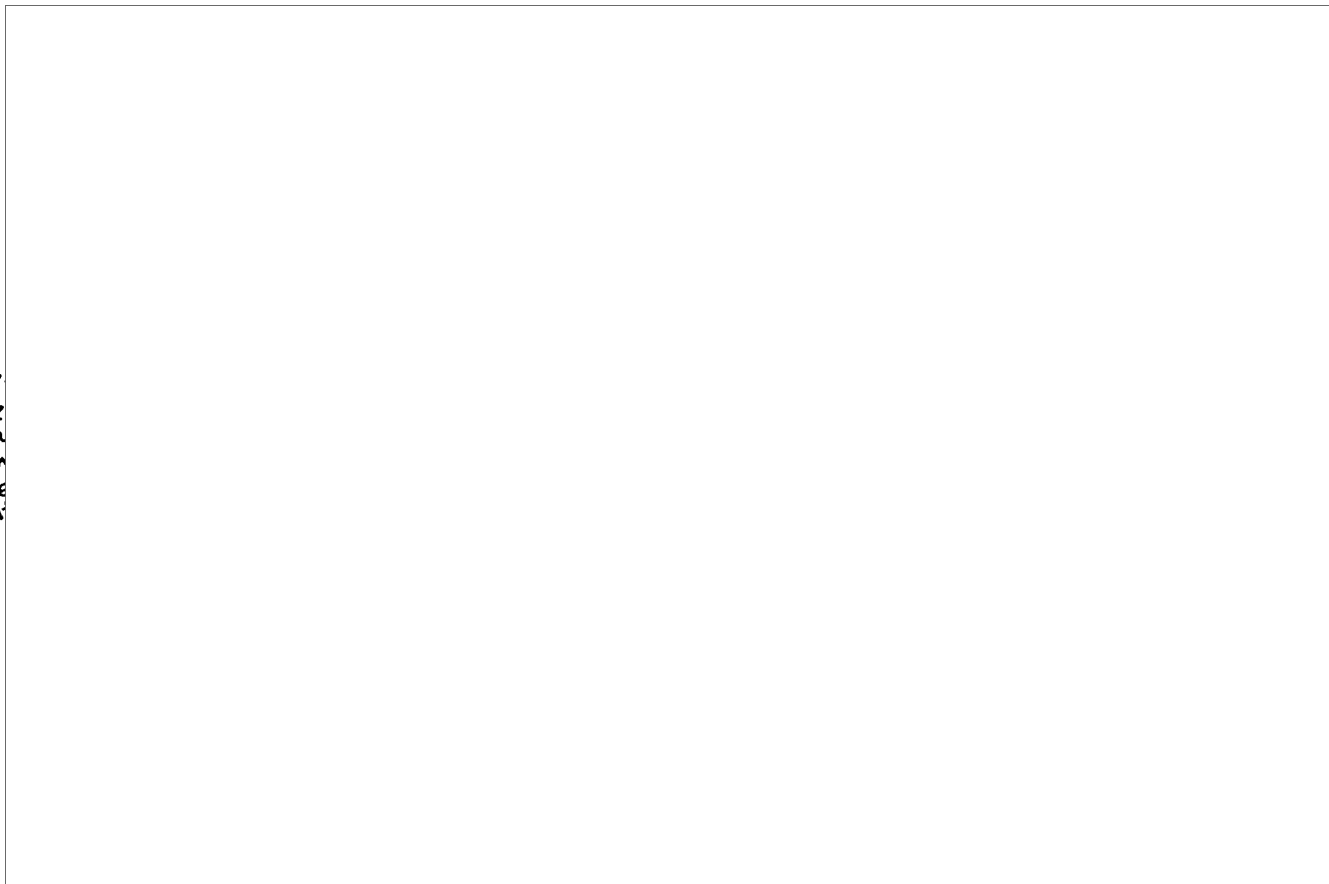

1. We request that you review subject Regulation and grant your approval in principle prior to submitting it to the Chiefs of Major Components for their concurrences and comments.



3. This Regulation was initiated by this Staff and has been coordinated with the Chiefs of Administrative Offices of the Deputy Director (Administration). With the exception of the Director of Security, all of these officials have concurred and their suggestions have been incorporated in the draft which is submitted to you herewith. The Director of Security has stated:

"As far as carrying out the functions assigned to the Director of Security, it is not believed that the proposed Regulation would result in an improvement of efficiency....."
