2. CENTRAL PEOPLE'S GOVERNMENT COUNCIL

This Council, elected by the PPCC, represents the People's Republic of China in International relations and assumes leadership of the state authority domestically. It exercises jurisdiction over all administrative, judicial and military functions of the government and has power of appointment and impeachment of government personnel. It is also charged with preparing for and eventually convoking the All-China People's Congress.
