Emb's further immediate reaction to composition new party organs  
EMBTTEL 685, Oct 17 is that:

- (1) Presidium breaks down into four groups: (A) ten members old Politburo; (B) two secys old CC plus chairman old party control comm (respectively, Ponomarenko, Suslov and Shkiryatov); (C) four econ specialists (Malyshev for machine-building, Saburov for planning, Pervukhin for electrical and chemical industries, Kuznetsov for trade unions and six party and ideological specialists) Leningrad party secy Andrianov; Ignatev, who in past has been central comit trouble-shooter; (party secy Melnikov; Chelyabinsk oblast party secy Aristov; editor "PROBLEMS OF PHILOSOPHY" Chesnokov; Komsomol Secy Mikhailov); (D) and two others, who because of age or status may be more or less honorary members (Kuusinen, who is chairman Presidium of Karelo-Finn Supreme Sov and 71 years old, and Korotchenko, who is chairman UKR Council Mens)
- (2) Candidate-members seem to break down into three groups: (A) three who possess both party and specialist qualifications (Min Light Industry Kosygin, who was member old Politburo; Pegov, who was Chief Light Industry Section old CC; Yudin, who is Chairman Cominform Journal Editorial Board); (B) four specialists (Vyshinsky for For Affairs; Zverev for Finance; Tevosyan for ferrous metalurgy; Kabanov, who may be specialist for electrical industry); (C) four party functionaries (Moldavian Party Secy Brezhnev, Krosnodar Krai Party Secy Ignatov, Belorussian Party Secy Patolichev, Kuibyshev Oblast Party Secy Puzanov).
- (3) Secretariat breaks down into two groups: (A) five members old Secretariat (Stalin, Malenkov, Ponomarenko, Suslov, Khrushchev); (B) five new members (Aristov, Brezhnev, Ignatov, Mikhailov, Pegov).
- (4) Shkiryatov has been promoted from deputy chairman old Party Control Comm of which Andreyev was chairman to chairman new comite of party control.
- (5) Moskatov keeps old job as chairman new Central Auditing Comm.

Perhaps worth noting that of Presidium members other than old Politburo, seven are known to be 50 years old or younger (Ponomarenko, Suslov, Andrianov, Malyshev, Pervukhin, Melnikov, Mikhailov).
