MEMORANDUM FOR THE OPERATIONS COORDINATING BOARD

SUBJECT: 25X1C
Unified Information Program for the Far East

As a result of the consideration by the Board Assistants of draft plan D-44, Intensified Use of Formosa Facilities for Psychological Operations, the following is presented for the consideration of the Board at its meeting on October 28, 1953.

The Board Assistants and OCB Staff recommend that:

- a. The Operations Coordinating Board approve in principle the concept that ~~unified~~ foreign information programs be developed for the Far East. ~~coordinated~~ 25X1C
- b. The OCB agree in principle to the inclusion of [REDACTED] facilities and assets in this program.
- c. The specific operational plan (D-44) be referred to a Working Group for further staff consideration and development in greater detail prior to approval by the Board.
- d. The plan specifically include provisions for necessary field study and coordination.
- e. The chairman for the Working Group be the CIA representative.
