1. [redacted] developed a monograph on "Facts of Freedom," which received circulation among the PSB staff and our staff. Although many did not fully subscribe to his tenets, he did reflect the philosophy of a deep thinker and high motivation—considered by some as a "brain."

2. He is [redacted] not an American citizen. One of our people met him socially and was highly impressed. A cursory check of the files indicate nothing of a derogatory or subversive nature on his record.

3. It occurred to some of us that he might be a point of contact for delineation of some of his views on the ideological matter and could possibly be of some assistance to your panel in its initial stages. He apparently has the time and inclination to devote some effort to it and you might feel that he has something to contribute. At any rate, accept this as an informal suggestion, and not an official recommendation, toward utilizing him in some fashion as a consultant for the Ideological Warfare panel.
