CIA job review

The Director and Deputy Director, GAAD, and E. L. Pahl met on August 21, 1961, to discuss the status of and plans for our audit of the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA).

The meeting was essentially limited to advising the Deputy Director of the extent of the audit work completed and presently under way, and the present status of our reporting on CIA audits. Our present audit effort has not yet developed any tentative findings. It is a holding operation until such time as the Kilday group of the House of Representatives Armed Services Committee requests Office officials to appear before them for discussion of our conclusions and findings on the audit of CIA activities. We are in a position to promptly discuss this in detail with, or issue a report to this group. This reporting material is retained at the site. Copies of correspondence between GAO, the Kilday Group, and CIA are maintained by the Director in his job file and his personal security files.
