

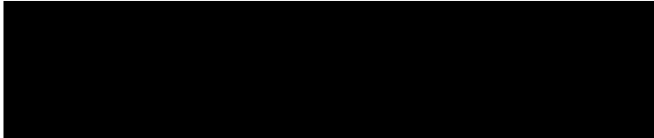

MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Personnel

SUBJECT : Collection of Data on Duty Performed Outside of the United States

1. Beginning 1 July 1958, the Office of the Comptroller undertook the responsibility of providing information, on an interim basis, to the Office of Personnel on duty performed by staff employees and staff agents outside of the United States. These data were for the purpose of being made a part of personnel records and the subject of actuarial analysis.

2. This Office would appreciate advice as to the necessity for it to continue to provide this information since it was understood when this program was initiated last year that the Office of Personnel would undertake the problem of developing procedures whereby the desired information could be obtained from official personnel files without relying on the records of this Office.
