Regulation [REDACTED] Career Planning for Individuals

25X1A

1. The following material has been added to the text of Regulation [REDACTED] as approved by the Council at its meeting on 26 July, and published as of 5 October 1956.

to paragraph 1. GENERAL --

"c. The provisions of this regulation regarding Career Preference Outlines do not apply to personnel while in the overseas field, and Form No. 1030 will not be sent to the overseas field."

to paragraph 3a of POLICY, the following material which is underlined --

"a. Career Preference Outlines will be prepared for any staff employee or staff agent, except those in the overseas field, if, in the opinion of the individual and/or his supervisor, with the concurrence of the Head of his Career Service, such documentation for the individual is required or desirable. Heads of Career Services will require outlines for such persons in their service as considered necessary. Career Preference Outlines will not be required or requested of personnel while they are at overseas field installations."

2. The Deputy Director (Intelligence) has requested the Council to consider whether the prohibition of sending the Career Preference Outline overseas should be waived in the case of certain components or whether the regulation should be republished in its original form in order to remove the overall prohibition.
