

- 1. The United States Intelligence Board at its meeting of 28 February 1961 assigned responsibility to the Security Committee in coordination with the Committee on Documentation to prepare recommendations for USIB action on Recommendation No. 42, namely, "The United States Intelligence Board should strongly support the efforts initiated in the counter-audio surveillance field by the National Security Council Special Committee on Technical Surveillance Countermeasures." In addition, the USIB instructed the Security Committee to furnish to the Board an initial report of progress within 30 days.
- 2. At its meeting of 2 March 1961, the Security Committee considered this recommendation and agreed that its Chairman should address a memorandum to the Chairman of the Special Committee on Technical Surveillance Countermeasures bringing the recommendation to his attention and requesting his assistance in identifying those efforts initiated in the counter-audio surveillance field to which study could be given by the Security Committee to the end of recommending appropriate action to the USIB.
