As of 3:00 this afternoon, we have 14 probables for the breakfast. Attached is a one-page list plus individual sheets with photos and biographic profiles of each.

Further to our phone conversation, note that they are all Republicans and a few, such as Kemp and Heinz, are apparently close to the White House and the party leadership.

In addition to the points I mentioned this morning--our mission and functions, general organization, where we fit into the community, and our relations with the Congress-- you might want to give them a couple of groups on importance of security (our "fiduciary" relations) and your statutory responsibilities for sources and methods. You may also want to offer a few comments about your (often misunderstood) responsibilities under the community reorganization.

As a way of breaking off, you (Colby or I if you've had to leave before that) could comment at 9:30 that we understand that many of them want to be back on the Hill at 10:00 and if any of them need transportation, we can provide it.

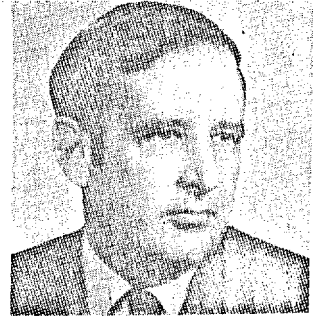
