SUBJECT : The Question of Reinstating the "100 Universities" Program

1. The attached paper weighs the proposal that a new version of the 100 Universities program be considered. Although treated more broadly and phrased more judiciously than my quick memo to you of 18 May 1973, the present paper still comes down on the hesitant side -- for a number of reasons.

2. In preparing this piece I have (a) been guided by your notes; (b) consulted Executive Registry's files, including the February 1968 [redacted] to Red White) Final Report of the Ad Hoc Committee which recommended that the University Associates Program and its accompanying 100 Universities endeavor be terminated; (c) read the [redacted] files concerning the 100 Universities, and chatted with [redacted] and [redacted] and (d) discussed the question with [redacted] (who was a member of the [redacted] committee and personally wrote much of that Final Report).

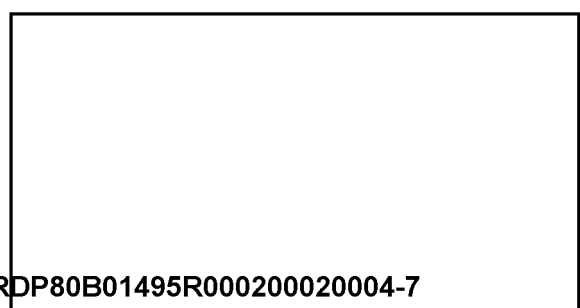
