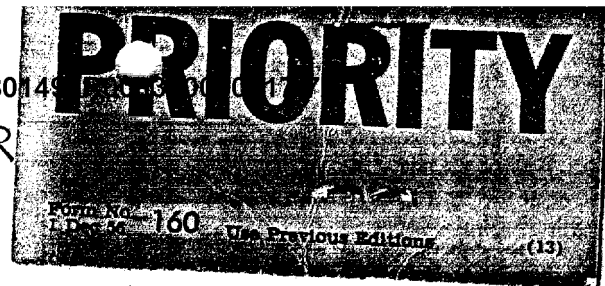

The enclosed two manuscripts are submitted for your approval. They have been sized for publication, and the conversational tone, which we feel is important, has been preserved.


